



Step 1 : Go to uk.match.com using Internet Explorer and double click on 'Protected Mode: On'



Step 3 : Click 'OK' to confirm the changes

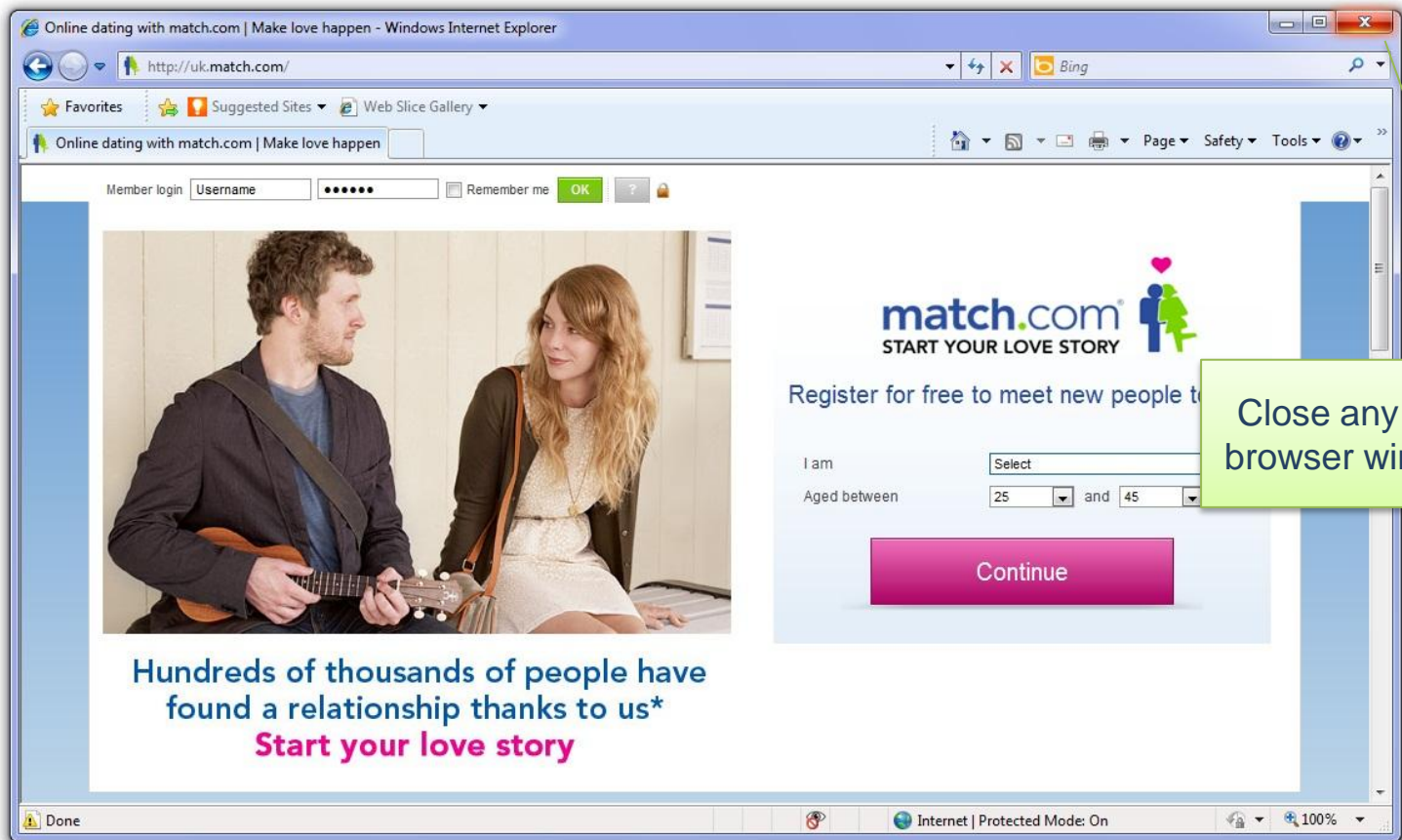
