






**Step 2** : Deselect protected mode and click on 'OK'

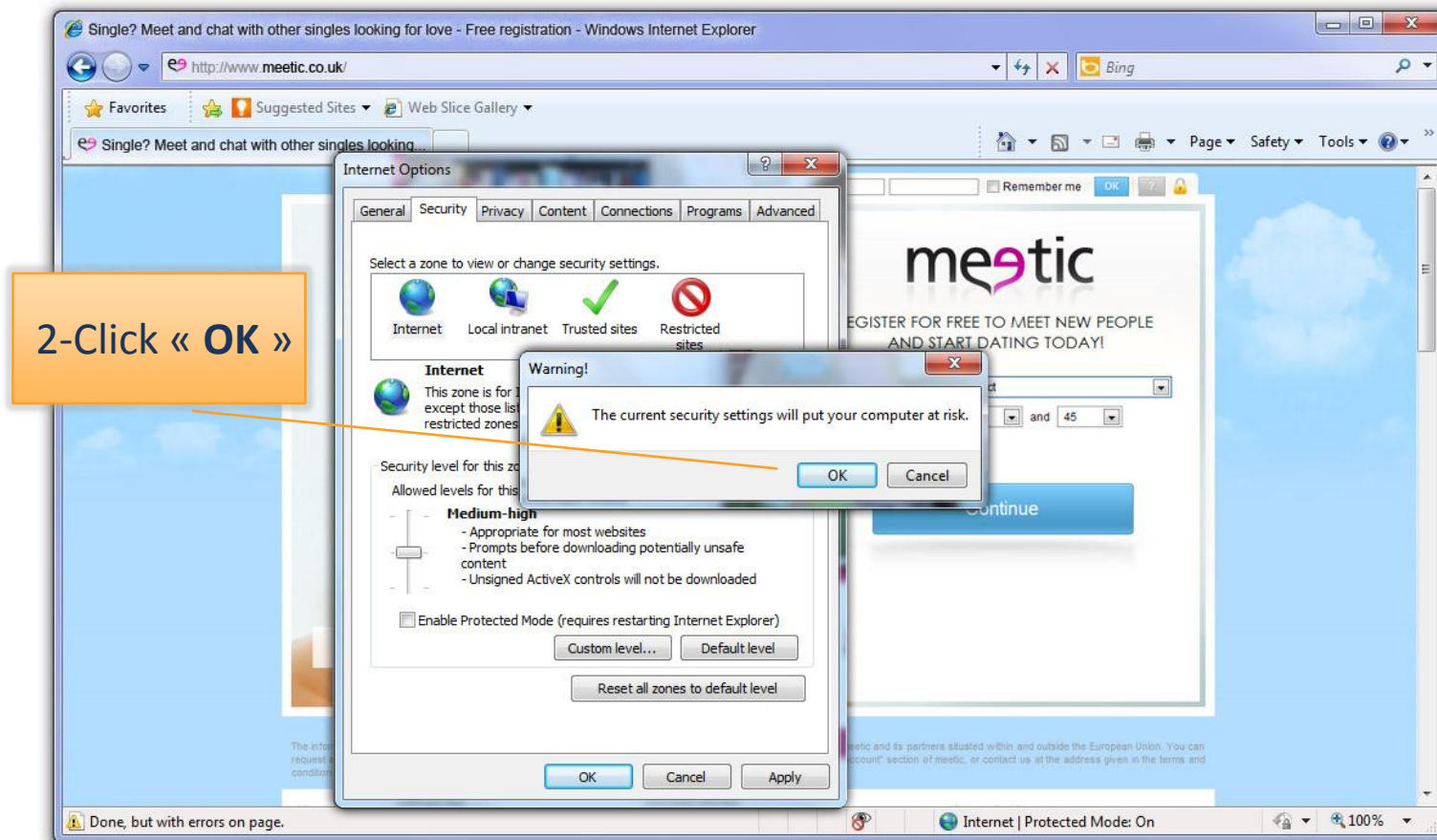

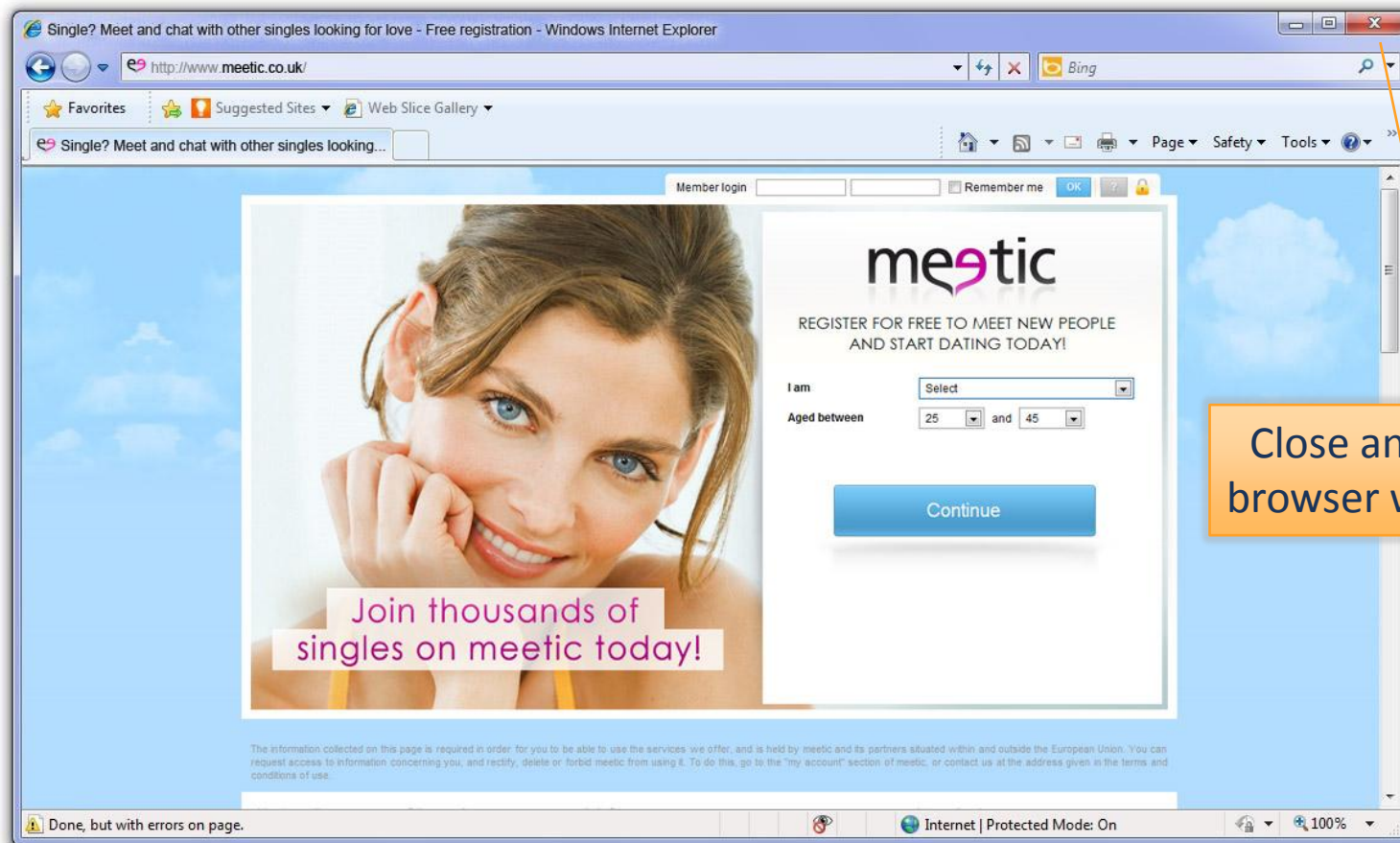
**1-Deselect «Enable Protected Mode»**

**Step 3 :** Click 'OK' to confirm the changes

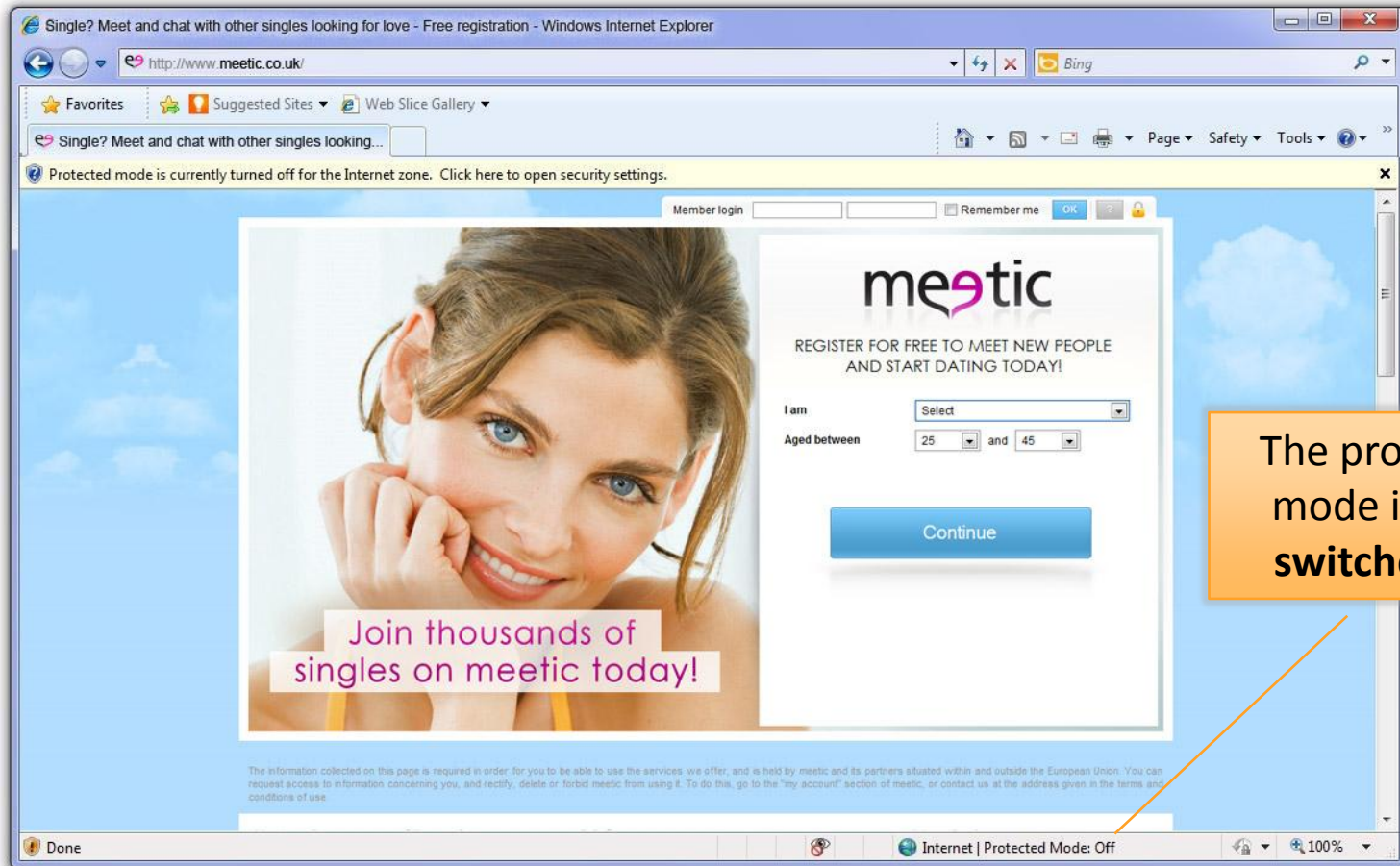


## Step 4 : Close any open Internet Explorer pages
